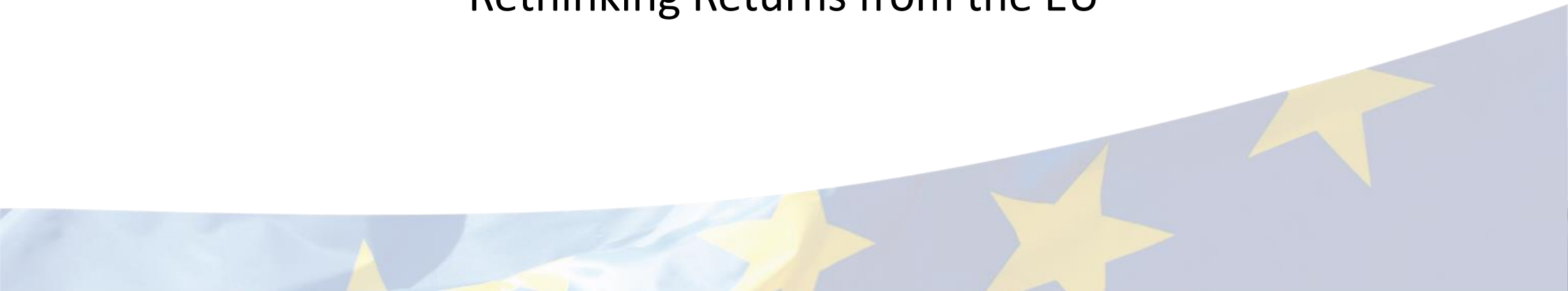

Rethinking Returns from the EU



Aim of ERIN

- 2012 – Pilot project European Reintegration Instrument (ERI)
- Shared challenges on implementation of reintegration
- Cost-efficiency; possibility for EU MS with smaller return numbers
- One European approach, one single window for reintegration



Concept of ERIN

- ERIN partners (19) determine target countries
- Procurement expertise to procure ERIN services
- Flat rate service fee principle – one fee per head => covered by ERIN budget
- Reintegration package provided by ERIN partners => not covered by ERIN budget
- Implementation reintegration policy in accordance with national policy ERIN partners



Best Practices and Lessons Learnt

- Procurement expertise
- Information sessions with civil society organisations in target countries
- Counselling sessions Service Providers in MS
- Amount flat rate service fee not decisive for awarding service contract. More focus on quality of services and methodology.



Programme/ Future Planning

- Procurement procedure new third countries ongoing
- First steps towards a more harmonised AVRRE policy
- Special attention for frontline MS
- ERIN should be detached from the individual EU MS level in due time and become a truly European platform
- Three scenarios for structural cooperation in reintegration
