Documentary **Refugees: Who needs them?** (2012, 74min., English subtitles), by US born filmmaker, Miles Roston, follows for a year the dramatic story of four migrants – Fathi from Libya, Fasil from Ethiopia, Li Zhu from China and Renuka from Bhutan who were forced to leave their homes.

Screening will be followed by discussion with internationally recognised experts – Caroline Van Buren (UNHCR Regional Representation for Central Europe), Michael Gray (IOM Geneva Headquarters) and José Angel Oropeza (IOM Coordinating Office for the Mediterranean) – about forced migration and its causes, refugees and ways to help.

The whole event will be conducted in English with no translation provided.
